

Submission - 'typing' of bacterial isolates at SU / CCUG

Any bacterial isolate may be 'typed' ! Most species of may be promptly identified at low cost. Uncommon species may be identified if different methods are applied. Some isolates cannot be identified, because they belong to novel species with no references, although these isolates may be characterized and the phylogenetic affiliation may be determined. CCUG accepts pure cultures of non-extremophilic bacteria for identification/characterization. The CCUG will decide on the method to use for rapid, reliable and most cost-efficient identification.
